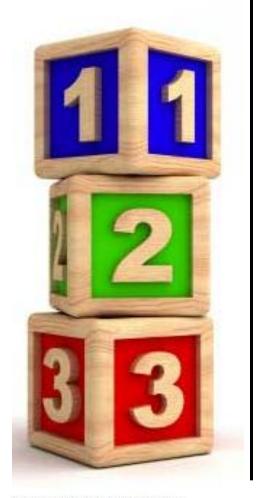
A Brownfield development that leverages on its own strengths

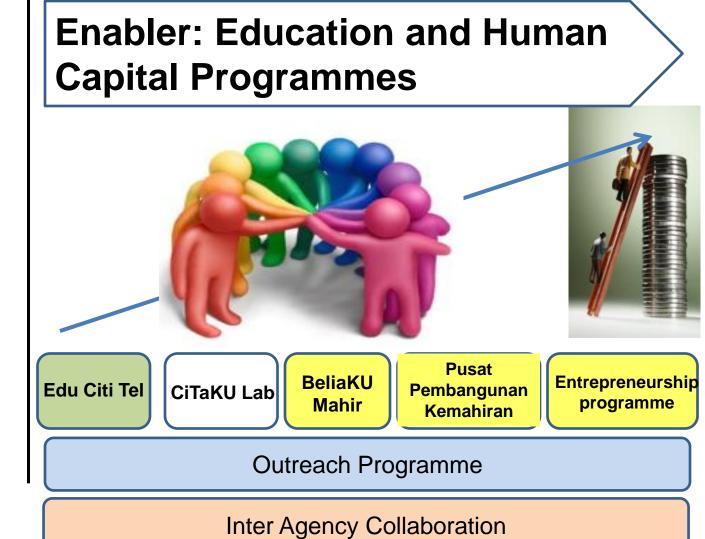

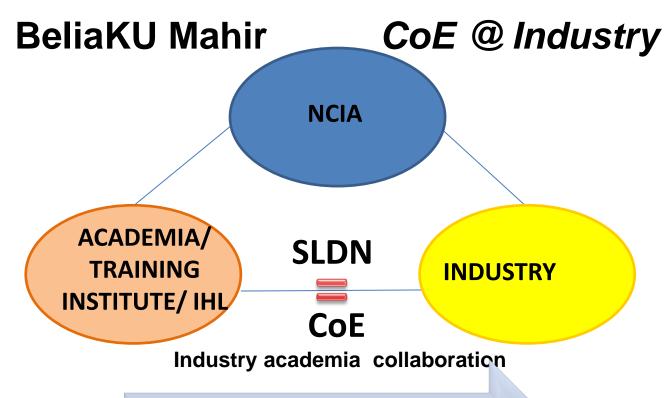
